

What is a Quarter Auction?

- Each guest receives a bidding paddle with a number on it
- The paddles are used to bid on auction items by holding them up when the item's number is called
- Each paddle has a corresponding numbered slice on the wheel which will be spun to determine the winner of the item
- Once the auction begins, the auctioneer assistant will hold up the item that's up for bid and will share how many quarters are required to bid on the item
- If you would like to bid on the item, you will put the designated number of quarters into the bucket per paddle that you wish to bid with. For example, if you have two paddles and want to bid with both of them to double your chances of winning, and the item is a "one-quarter" bid, then you would put .50 in the bucket and raise your paddles.
- Once all bids are in – the wheel is spun and the winning number announced
- If the winning numbered paddle is in the air (quarters placed in the bucket), the holder of the paddle wins the item
- If the winning numbered paddle is not in the air (no quarters bid for that number), the wheel is spun again until a winning bidder is found

What is an "All In Paddle"?

- All in Paddles give you one entry into every basket being auctioned with no additional quarters necessary
- Our event plans on a minimum 100 baskets – if each basket were a 4 quarter bid, the All In Option saves you \$20 and allows you to be entered for every drawing
- All in Paddles are a great option if you want to enjoy the event, but not worry about paying attention to the item being raffled and focus your attention on socializing
- All in Paddles also allow you to participate, even if you can't make the event
- Each person who purchases an All In Paddle will also receive a Quarter Bidding Paddle at No Extra Cost

Am I able to Participate if I Can't Join the Event Live?

- Yes – With the All In

Can I purchase additional Bidding Paddles so that I may bid more than once on a basket I really love?

- Absolutely! Additional bidding paddles are \$10

Can I join the fun without bidding?

- Certainly! With a \$30 admission, you will receive one bidding paddle. Feel free to “donate” the paddle to a friend or make it a “Community” bidding paddle at your table.

What should I bring to the auction?

- If you haven’t already paid for your admission (which includes your paddle), bring cash or your Venmo or PayPal payment option
- Quarters to bid (don’t worry, we will have some if you run short)
- Snacks
- Beverages of choice (alcoholic and non-alcoholic allowed)

What’s included in admission prices?

- \$80 All In Admission gets you one All in Paddle and one Bidding Paddle
- \$30 Admission gets you one Bidding Paddle
- All Admission options above include pizza, salad, sweet treats, water and tea
